## **Applicants**

- The Call is addressed to non-EU applicants who are not residing in Italy and are applying for a Visa at the Italian diplomatic or consular representations.
- Applicants must have a study qualification obtained abroad and be willing to enroll in the Master's Degree Programme in INTERNATIONAL MANAGEMENT for the Academic Year 2021-2022.
- The places available are <u>81</u> in total, of which 1 is reserved to the applicant who wins the UNICORE 3.0 University Corridors for Refugees 2021-2022 call for applications of UNIMORE, available on the website https://www.unimore.it/mobilita/unicore.html



## **Deadline**

# APPLICATIONS must be submitted by **10**<sup>th</sup> **June 2021**

Applicants shall be subject to a verification of their personal training that will be carried out based on their study qualification with a possible interview by remote.



#### Submitting the online application

- Register to the website www.esse3.unimore.it (personal data)
- Get your <u>username</u> and <u>password</u> to access to the Registered/Student Area.

Please check that the e-mail address provided is correct in order to receive any future communications



- Log in and access the Registered/Student Area

- Select "Admission" from the menu tab

Answer "Yes" to the following question: "Are you an International student with a foreign degree, residing abroad, applying for a visa through the Italian Embassy/Consulate?".



Fill out the online application and attach the documents listed below:

- certificate of the qualification obtained: type of study qualification, when and where it was obtained (in which university), the list of examinations taken with the relevant scores. Students may attach a copy of the University diploma and all documents that may be useful to prove knowledge and skills in the following fields: Business Administration, Marketing, Management, Economics, Statistics and Mathematics.
- Syllabus (written in English) for each exam taken
- a reference letter (preferably written by a university professor) that may be attached to the online application or e-mailed by the Referee to info.economia@unimore.it
- International English language certificate at least a B2 level (Common European Framework of Reference) or alternatively a declaration issued by the home UNIMOINERSITY (Language Centre or Department) on University headed paper, written in English and reporting the level obtained.



- European Computer Driving Licence (ECDL) or, alternatively, the documents certifying the applicant's IT skills, should they have not been indicated in the study programme
- Personal paper written in English in which the applicant explains the reasons for applying
- Curriculum vitae, written in English in accordance with the Europass model 3
- any other qualifications that applicants want to be considered for admission purposes (e.g. internships, university master programmes, further education, etc.).

#### **Enrollment**

The following documents must be submitted for the enrolment:

- Bachelor degree diploma, translated and legalised by the Italian Embassy/Consulate
- declaration of value of the university degree, issued by the Italian Embassy/Consulate in the country to which the school issuing the qualification belongs or alternatively, a declaration by ENIC-NARIC centres
- degree certificate, issued by the University
- post office receipt, certifying the filing of the residence permit request
- passport
- photo, passport size



#### **Enrollment**

After verifying the correctness and completeness of the documents submitted by the student, the Registrar's Office issues the slips for the tuition fee for a.y. 2021-2022 and confirms the enrolment once the first instalment has been paid.
