

Participation Requirements

DEMB's students enrolled at least in the second year (a.y. 2021/2022) of the bachelor or master's degree courses offered by the Department

Students who are going to graduate in the A.Y. 2020/2021: mobility possible only in the 1st semester

Procedure to participate (ask to the Student mobility Office of UNIMORE for more info)

Call: once a year

Language proficiency

- Evidence of language proficiency is required in accordance with the requirements of the Call for applications.
- Students who are not able to demonstrate adequate knowledge of the foreign language according to the above requirements will have to take an assessment test in order to identify their language level.
- Students who get A0 or A1, will have to attend a mandatory preparation course before departure (the course will be offered free of charge by the University Language Center).
- Students who get A2 or B1, may attend the preparation course voluntarily. Attendance, however, is strongly recommended.

The selection process (I)

Only one selection for the whole Department

IMPORTANT NOTICE

- Students must rank the host institutions according to preference while filling their application
- A SELECTION OF TEN HOST INSTITUTIONS IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED
- Students must mandatorily fill a google form necessary to collect some data
- Students must undergo a mandatory remote motivational interview with the International Relations Committee (at DEMB).

The selection process (II)

Selection will be on the basis of:

- Language proficiency;
- Year course and taken exams;
- Average scores;
- Aptitude and motivation shown during motivational interview;
- Ability to link the period of study abroad and the academic syllabus or Master's thesis so to make the stay profitable
- Exams validated by the referee of the Master's degree program or check of the host institution validatable exams (at least 70/80% content compatibility)

MASTER COURSE STUDENTS

SHOULD

- Check the website of the partner universities they are interested in
- Download the compatible course programmes available there
- Apply for validation to the president of their Master Course, at least 4 days before the motivational interview, through the specific section on DOLLY PLATFORM
- Upload the partner university course programmes matching them to the corresponding Italian courses they would like to validate
- Present the validations signed by the president on the day of the motivational interview.

Applications without the president's signature won't be accepted

BACHELOR COURSE STUDENTS

SHOULD

- Check the website of partner universities.
- Choose the institutions they are interested in and list them in the application form
- Check the partner university course programmes and identify the validatable exams compatible with their study plans
- Upload their proposal to DOLLY PLATFORM
- Evaluation of the validatable list of exams will be carried out during the motivational interview

Selection process

 At the end of the selection process a ranking list will be published

 According to the above mentioned list, each student will be selected on the basis of:

 the academic offer at the host institution (highest number of validatable exams)

the most preferred host institution

Selection process

- The motivational interview results will be published on DOLLY PLATFORM (dolly.economia.unimore.it>programma Erasmus)
- Selected students must mandatorily provide feedback on the assigned host institution within 3 days, so that the international relations board can make up a definitive ranking list – (after possible candidates' withdrawals and subsequent repechage). The resulting ranking list will be sent to the Mobility Office.
- Students who withdraw won't be given a second chance.
- Selected students must give formal acceptance to the Student Mobility Office once the final ranking has been published on the University website http://www.unimore.it/bandi/StuLau-internaz.html in compliance with what stated in the Call.

Exams to take

Validated exams depend on the assigned host institution

 Conversions depend on the compatibility of the host institution programmes and the Italian one

 Information available at the moment refers to past experiences, it doesn't guarantee future conversion (conversion is usually verified)

To sum up:

- Applications must be submitted online
- Nb Annex 2 must be carefully filled (language skills, partial and full exams)
- Language proficiency tests will be organized following the department selection process
- Erasmus experience can be repeated at each study cycle
- Within each study cycle, students have a 12 month mobility "package"

Double Degree with Bochum (Germany)

Reserved to students enrolled in IM

At the first year students should apply for a one year academic stay in Bochum -at the same time
as the Erasmus+ Call – (second year: exams + internship)

Pre-requisites. Bachelor in Economics, English proficiency level C1
